Mr. Linus Koh is an active member of the Royal Falcon Fleet Plc Advisory Board. Mr. Linus Koh has been engaged in the financial services industry for over 25 years. He is the founder and Chairman of Nutmeg Solutions Pte Ltd, a regional corporate and financial advisory firm based in Singapore.

From 2004 to 2007, he was Executive Vice President of the Singapore Exchange, most recently as its Chief Financial Officer. Prior to becoming CFO, Mr Koh led the development and management of listed securities, derivatives products, and exchange services to promote trading access and market participation.

Before joining the Singapore Exchange, Mr Koh was Executive Director & Chief Operating Officer at publicly-listed securities firm G. K. Goh Holdings Limited, Singapore from 2000-2004. He was with Deutsche Bank from 1995-2000, first assigned to London as Chief Operating Officer, Global Foreign Exchange, then relocating to Singapore in 1997 as COO for Global Markets, Asia and subsequently appointed COO for all of the Bank's Asia Pacific businesses.

Mr Koh began his professional career in capital markets and investment banking with Citibank NA in 1983, and has served in various roles at UBS, Singapore; Morgan Grenfell (Asia) Ltd, Singapore; and State Street Bank & Trust Co in Boston, USA.

Mr Koh currently serves as Council Secretary of the Singapore Institute of International Affairs. He is a graduate of the Massachusetts Institute of Technology and Sheffield University, and completed Harvard Business School's Advanced Management Program.
