



### **MR. DENNIS C. CARROLL**

Mr Dennis C Carroll is the Executive Vice President (Shipbuilding) of Royal Falcon Fleet Plc with responsibility for the various vessels currently under construction.

Born in Gibraltar in 1951, he graduated from the Royal Dockyard College there in 1973 and held various positions at HM Naval Base until its privatization in 1984. During the period 1984-85 he underwent commercial marine management training, including sea-time with BP Shipping and ship repair project management with Keppel Shipyard in Singapore.

Upon completion he return to Gibraltar to take up a management appointment at the new Gibrepair Ltd facilities. During the period 1985-94 he held various positions including Project Manager, Production Manager and Purchasing Manager. In the later period the company was bought out by the Kvaerner Group of Norway.

In 1994 he moved to Singapore and took up the appointment of Procurement Manager at Kvaerner Fjellstrand (S) Pte Ltd. In 1998 he became its Senior Operations Manager.

With the takeover of the Fjellstrand yard by the Dutch Damen Shipyards Group in 2000, he was appointed its General Manager and was promoted to Managing Director in 2003 which he held for 6 years till 2009. He remained a member of the board of directors of Damen Shipyards Singapore until May 2010.

After a short period in a consultancy role with DryDocksWorld (SEA) in Singapore, in November 2009 he assumed his current role with RFF.

During his career, Mr Carroll has served as a council member of the Association of Singapore Marine Industries (ASMI), a committee member of the Classification Society Bureau Veritas South East Asian Technical Committee and also on the Marine Industries Committee of the Singapore Workplace Safety & Health Council.
