Between 1997 – 2007, Mr. Zaman was the Senior Executive VP – Business Development Asia Pacific, for Millicom International Cellular S.A. (MIC). MIC is the telecommunication flagship of the Kinnevik Group of Sweden and is listed on NASDAQ and on the Stockholm Stock Exchange.

He joined the Kinnevik group in 1993 as the President & CEO of Comvik International Vietnam AB and served the group under various capacities such as Chairman of Comvik, Senior Vice President of MIC, Vice President of Business Development Asia Pacific for Kinnevik, Chairman of Mobitel – Cambodia, Chairman of Tele2 – Cambodia, Chairman of Cambodia Television Network (CTN), and Chairman of Millicom Laos Company Ltd – Laos.

Under his leadership, Millicom rose to a prominent telecommunication and television operator in the Indo-China region. He secured a Business Co-operation Contract with the Government of Vietnam, which led to the formation of MOBIFONE network between CIV and VMS - Vietnam Mobile Services (1995 -2005). MOBIFONE is a multibillion dollar enterprise and is considered to be the best mobile telephony company in Vietnam.

Mr. Zaman started his career in 1979 as a Commercial Pilot and Flight Instructor, after graduating from Burnside Ott Aviation Training Center in Miami, Florida. Between 1984 - 1989, he owned and managed highly profitable travel agencies - Navana Tours AB, Navana International & Tours AB, Sweden. Between 1989 - 1993 he was the President & CEO of Continental Business Network (CBN) in Sweden.
